




Sources of funds.

A day in the life.

At any hour on any given day, the MPHA staff takes strategic steps toward improving public policies, increasing funding, dismantling the causes of health inequities, and fostering healthy, thriving, and just communities. These thousands of steps over the course of a year have one singular aim: to create a strong alliance for public health.







MPHA tripled down on our community partnerships to counter the onslaught of attacks by the federal government on evidence-based health policies, public health infrastructure, healthcare access, and the rolling back of efforts to address climate change, homelessness, substance use disorder, reproductive health, and more.

Oami joins strategy call with legislative and community allies to pass substance use disorder legislation to expand life-saving treatment, recovery options, and harm reduction services across Massachusetts.

While overdose deaths have been declining, fatality rates for Black, Latine, and people of color remain disproportionately high due to the legacy of the racist war on drugs. Passed in December 2024, this legislation marked a departure from punitive models toward evidence-based approaches to substance use disorders.





Kate finalizes our state budget analysis, laying the foundation for MPHA's budget strategy. Then, she meets with the Massachusetts Large Cities Health Coalition (MLCHC) to discuss leveraging their public health expertise to advance housing justice campaigns.

MPHA led the implementation of MLCHC's strategic plan in FY25, providing advocacy trainings, helping define Executive Committee roles, and establishing policy endorsement processes that build essential coalition infrastructure. MLCHC—a collaboration between the public health leadership of the 14 largest cities in the Commonwealth—is uniquely positioned to advance equitable systems change to address health disparities.

MPHA advocated for housing policies to reinforce the safety net that protects people and families with children from homelessness. These solutions included investments in upstream programs like Residential Assistance for Families in Transition, Massachusetts Rental Voucher Program, and HomeBASE; ensuring safe, quality housing through the Massachusetts Healthy Homes Program; banning no-fault evictions; and stabilizing rents.

The MPHA Spring Awards Breakfast is both a fundraiser and community building event. Thanks to our generous sponsors, the 23rd annual event raised unrestricted dollars and brought together over 300 people to celebrate public health heroes, demonstrating our collective power for health, justice, and community.

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health administers the Public Health Excellence (PHE) grant program to build the capacity of local boards of health. Since April 2021, 92% of the Commonwealth's municipalities are supported across 51 cross-jurisdictional partnerships. MPHA put together a poster series highlighting the various collaboratives, from food safety to disease monitoring and public health nursing. The exhibit was the precursor to the "Day in the Life" video produced by our Communications Intern, Anna, featuring health inspectors in the Framingham Public Health Department.


