Public Health Excellence (PHE) funds have helped the Greater Boroughs Partnership for Health protect residents across the region through prevention, education, and timely health information, from lifesaving CPR and Narcan trainings to a regional flu clinic that brings residents together.



Rolling Up to Stay Healthy

For five years running, the Partnership has hosted its annual drive-through flu vaccine clinic, made possible each year through the collaboration and coordination of all four Greater Boroughs towns. **Vaccinating over 200 residents, the clinic has become a community tradition that brings the region together to protect public health.**

Building Skills That Save Lives

A bystander trained in CPR or how to administer Narcan can be the difference between life and death in the moments before help arrives. The Partnership provided 19 CPR trainings in FY26, reaching more than 100 residents with the skills to respond to a cardiac emergency. The team also led Narcan trainings across the community, including a session with Rep. Donaghue at the Northborough Library, where attendees learned how to respond in the event of an overdose, **building a community better prepared to step in when someone needs help most.**
